Others present were Brenda Grey, Velma Gober, Joe Miller, and Mercer Stone.


Greg Golden called the meeting to order and introduced the Board. Mayor Glenn motioned to approve the minutes from September 13, 1999 as sent out, Mr. McConnell seconded the motion, and all members voted unanimously to approve.


First on the agenda was George Walker's Lancaster Place Subdivision Phase II-Final Plat. Ms. Sheldon motioned to approve the final plat, Mr. McConnell seconded the motion, and all members voted unanimously in favor. The final plat was approved, the motion carried.

Next on the agenda was the Crommelin Property-Request to subdivide property at U.S. Hwy 231 and Bell Street. Mercer Stone represented the Crommelins. After discussion, it was concluded that the development of Bell Street will be determined by the next property owners. Mayor Glenn motioned to approve the plat that subdivides the property at U.S. Hwy 231 and Bell Street, Ms. Sheldon seconded, and the Board members voted unanimously for approval.
