Entries with accompanying applications must be delivered to the City of Wetumpka Administrative Building, 408 South Main Street (located next to the Wetumpka Civic Center) by 4 p.m. Monday, December 5, 2011. Entries can be picked up after 2 p.m. the day of the show or on Monday, December 12, 2011 at the administrative building.
